The Raleigh Fire Museum is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) charitable organization dedicated to the preservation and presentation of the history of firefighting in North Carolina's Capitol City.

What We're Doing

Several projects in size and scope have been completed, including creating a plaque for the old smokehouse, collecting and organizing all log books, and opening the first Raleigh Fire Department museum in May 2011.

Our museum is located in a classroom trailer at the Keeter Training Center, 105 Keeter Center Drive. It's open on the second Saturday of each month from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Raleigh Fire Museum staff members also conduct a history class for new recruits, produce a quarterly newsletter about fire department activities, and are involved with planning activities for the fire department's Centennial in 2012.
